 - Funded research programs


What is a non-traditional student?

• A traditional student


- College right after high school

What is a Facebook Group?

- A way to privately communicate with a specific group of people (club, students, alumni, faculty, advisory committee)
 - Opt-in by user
 - Facebook membership/account is required
- A way to engage students outside of the classroom
- A form of a learning community
 - Students collaborate, share, and help each other
 - Students hold each other accountable

Facebook Group

What it is not:

- A program marketing page to recruit new students ("Pages are against the College social media policy and prohibited due to the fact it's representing an entity." - Dir. of Marketing)
- A replacement of email to communicate important official Ivy Tech information
- A place to share/see personal information (you do not have to be FB "friends" with the group members)







Once the group is created, click the gear at the top right of the group and select **Edit Group Settings**. From here you can add a group description, tags, set up a group email address and add a group picture.



- Offer students opportunities to participate in Community Events/Volunteer Opportunities




